Last Thursday, Middle Years classes went to Warrnambool to the Art Gallery.

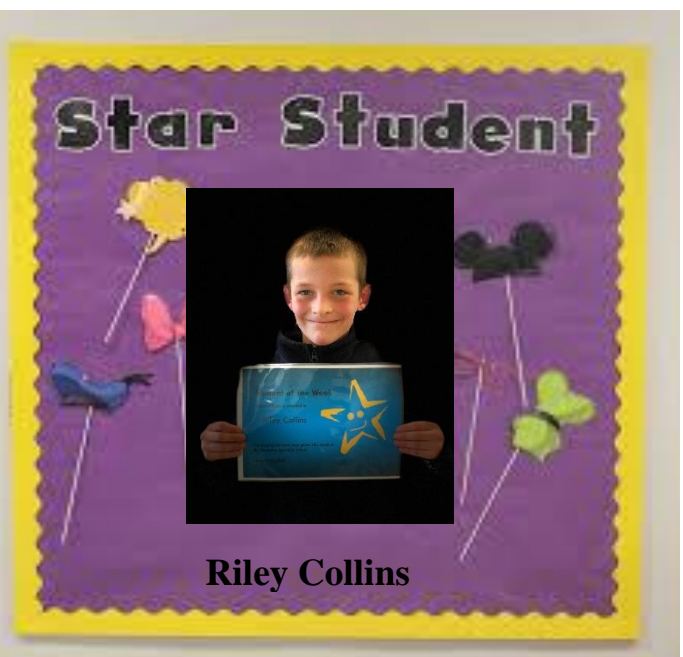
