Last Friday family and friends of the Friendship Group were treated to a fabulous fashion parade with clothing purchased from op shops. This was followed by an enjoyable high tea.



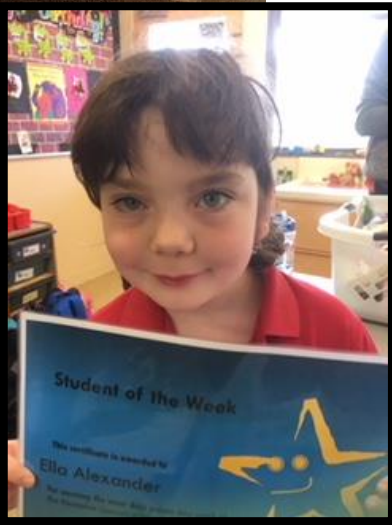
