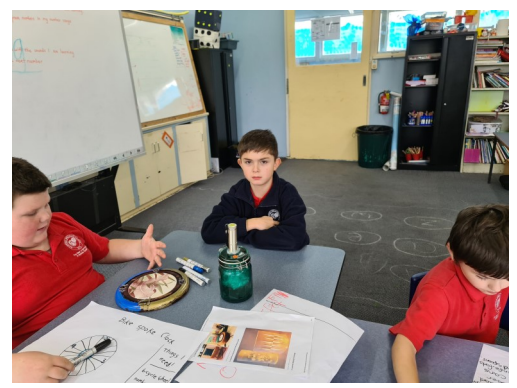
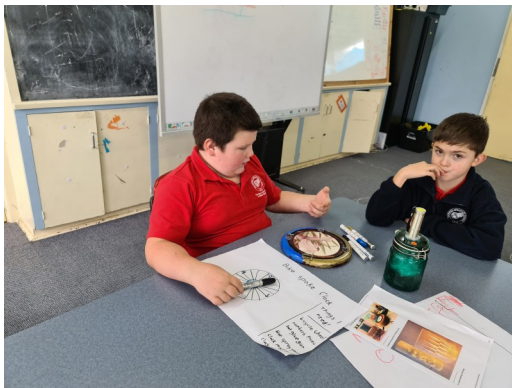
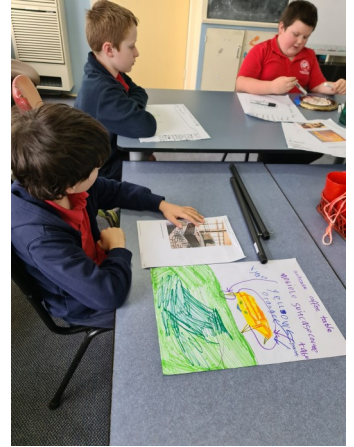
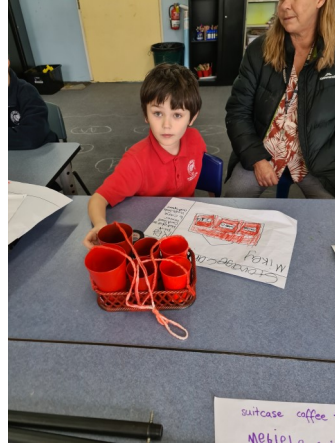


Eary Years Report 16/06/2022 Inquiry: Individual Upcycle Projects

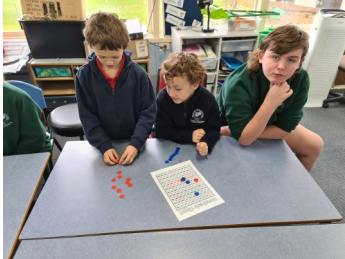
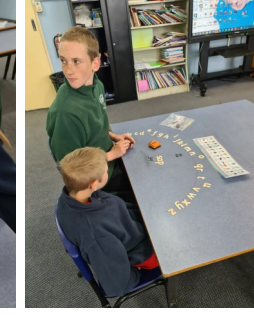
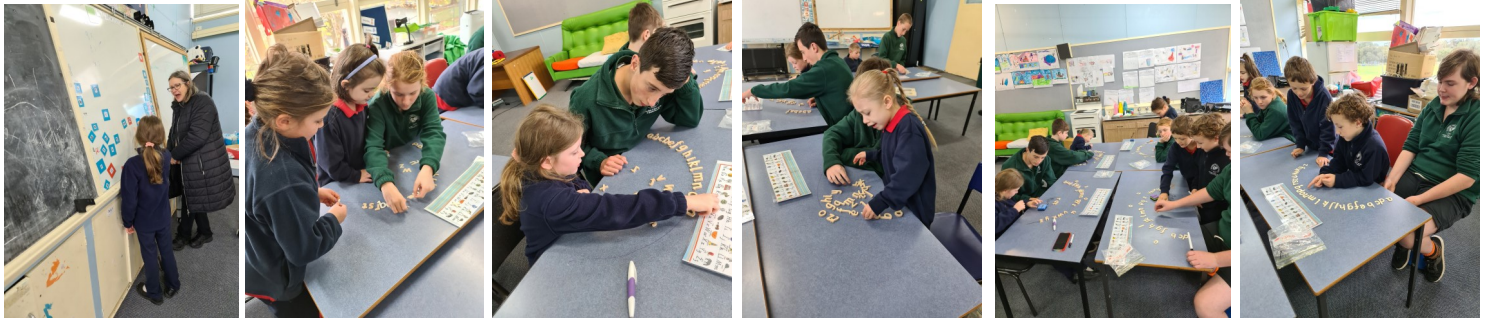
Real Schools Class Visits
