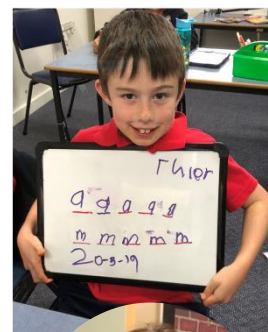


No lunch orders
